

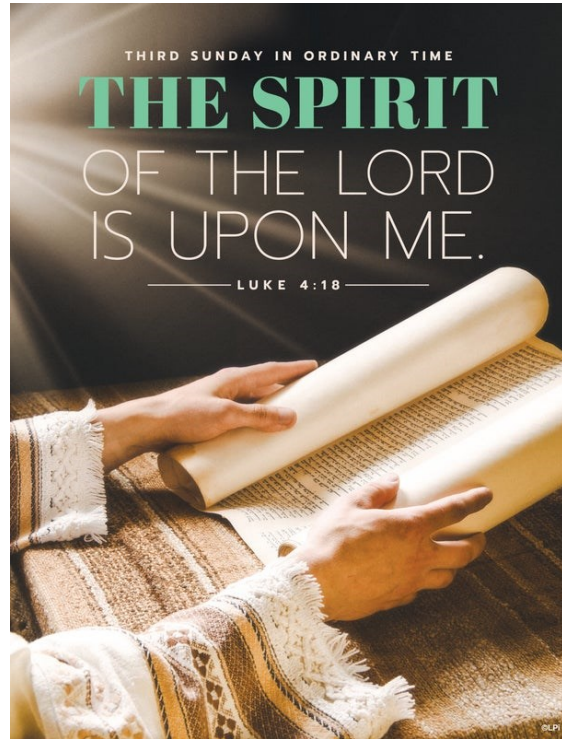

Diocesan Appeal

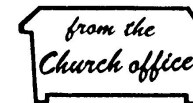
Our 2024-2025 Diocesan Appeal has begun. Opening this appeal early gives you the opportunity to spread the payments over a longer period of time.
