

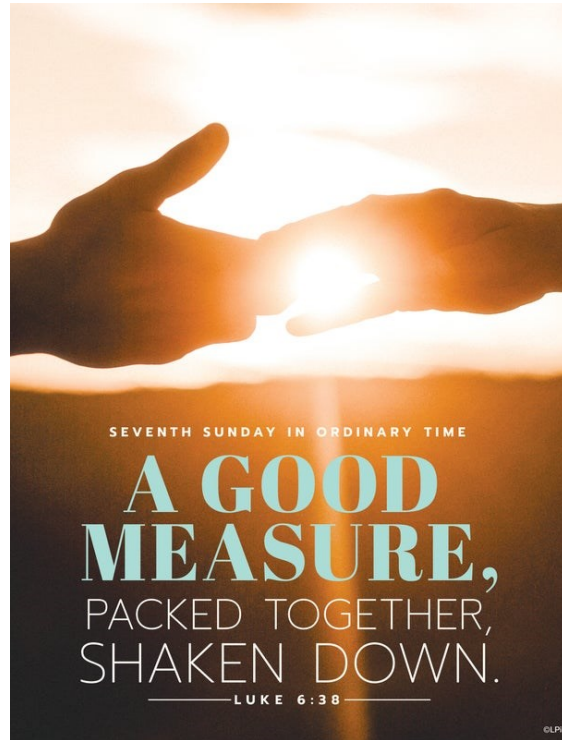

Diocesan
Appeal

Our 2024-2025 Diocesan Appeal has begun. The assessment for St. Cecilia's is \$14,278, This is \$147 more than last year. We have raised \$6,256 which is 44% of our assessment, along with 35 gifts. We need to raise \$8,022 to reach our goal! If we don't make our assessment it will need to come out of our operating funds, Last year we had to pay them a little over \$300. Arranges and assists in funeral planning. Responsible for cemetery transactions – sale of lots, ordering cornerstones and arranging for their installation and the digging of burial holes. Maintains cemetery records.

General secretarial duties i.e. answer telephone. Selects and orders bulletin covers and issues bulletins. Maintains Liturgical Desk Calendar for requested masses and tabernacle candles. Maintains log of same. Completes Prayers of the Faithful and the weekly announcements. Records all donations into Church office. Prepares tax letters and other mass mailings as needed. Provides support for Bookkeeper.

Kevin Belanger, Snow Removal

Responsible for clearing our walkways of snow and ice after each storm. Sands and salts as necessary.
